Belize--land of beauty

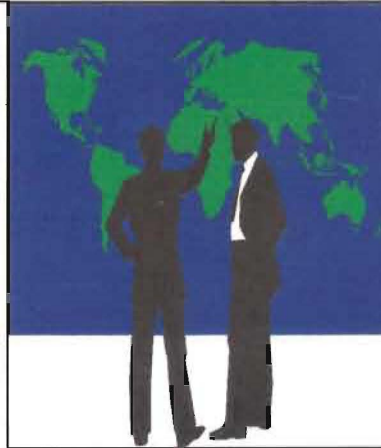
