### CLIFF'S CAR FINALLY DIES

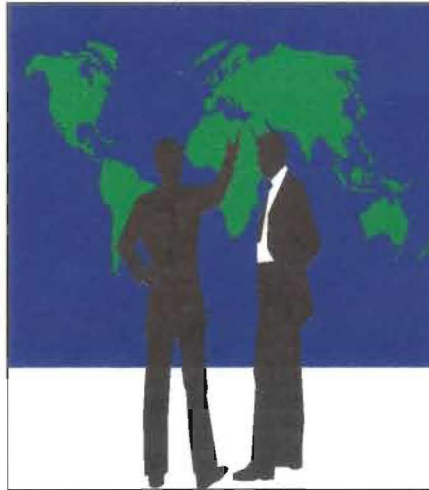
